I AGREE WITH QUINCY

In mid Spring we ran a classic Cru outreach: “I Agree With Quincy.”

Ever since Quincy could remember his dad wanted nothing to do with him. His mom raised him faithfully, but Quincy always longed for his dad’s approval. As he got older this longing transferred to teachers and coaches, and he was good at pleasing them. But the harder he worked, the less satisfying their approval was. Would they walk away if he failed them? He’d heard about Jesus, but at college he discovered what the love, grace and truth of Jesus felt like through other people. He eventually became a leader in Cru, and lived his faith in front of peers, teammates, coaches & professors.

In Fall 2025 David started meeting him for discipleship. Knowing it was his senior year, David asked what sort of impact the Lord might want him to leave at MU. Their meetings were regularly

interrupted by everyone on campus interjecting their “great to see you’s!” He was arguably the most recognizable (and admired) figure on campus. Jesus’ love for him drove him to love regardless of others’ status/achievements.

So this Spring, we ran the “I Agree With” outreach. Everyone in Cru posted they agreed with Quincy, invited friends, and heard his faith story. Normally 40-50 students join large group meetings. This event: 106 came! Quincy unashamedly shared while his search for approval looked acceptable on the outside, he’d never turned to God, until he encountered Jesus. Jesus told him though he could never do enough to earn the approval he sought, by trusting in Him and Him alone, God was fully pleased with him. It changed his life. 10+ students & 1 of his coaches indicated a desire to surrender their lives to Jesus. Praise God for the power of a changed life.
