

THE 3PM CLUB

What do a Muslim, Buddhist, Pentecostal, Catholic & Jehovah's Witness have in common? At CCNY, friendship; this is an actual friend group regularly wrestling through matters of faith.

One cold March day before sharing his faith, David prayed, "God lead me to someone who needs to hear the gospel today." He instantly overheard a group of guys actively debating morality's origins. Taking it as a sign, he started a Perspective Cards survey. They were hooked!

For **three hours they shared** their perspectives of God, life's

meaning/purpose & human nature. David fielded a constant stream of questions ranging from societal subjectivism to the reality of truth to the existence of love. And as they spoke more students (7!) joined the conversation. When time ran out they unanimously agreed the conversation wasn't over. Students started a group chat and named it: 'The 3pm Club.' Every Wed since David's met them in the cafeteria, discussing their obstacles to faith, and giving gospel answers.
