A God-Given New Name

Do you remember
Abram in the Old Testament? He
is considered the father of God's
people, the patriarch of the faith!
He was called away from his
home to inherit a foreign land,
and with trust he left. But he
desired children to carry on his
legacy; his name after all meant,

'exalted father.' God promised Abram offspring whose number would rival the stars, and because of Abram's belief in God he was considered righteous (Gen 15:6, Gal 3:6). After fifteen years Abram still had not seen the fulfillment of this promise, and God came to him with reassurance. In fact God came and gave him a new name with greater glory - rich with His purposes for Abram. He calls him Abraham, 'father of multitudes!' It is with this name and with this faith that Abraham fathered the beginning of the nation of Israel!

Recently, Campus Crusade has also encountered a name change. This is an exciting time! As far back as the '70's the founders realized the need, because they knew that 'campus' didn't really describe the whole function of the organization, and 'crusade' was somewhat misleading in contemporary culture.



Actually at its inception God gave Bill Bright and a board of interested believers the name Campus Crusade for

Christ, so it seems only appropriate that at His timing we would change it. We spent months researching and refining names that would adequately reflect our heart and mission, and after presenting 1,600 possibilities and praying ceaselessly God gave us: Cru. This is really no great change on campus, since students already call us Cru, but we are excited to fill this name with meaning for all our ministries!

As a side note, this will only be the name change for the US branches of ministry. Most countries around the world are known by another name (like Student Life in Australia), but still under the headship of Campus Crusade for Christ International.

Back to Indiana

After spending several amazing months living in Johnstown, I'm moved back into my apartment in Indiana, PA. Before I could get there though, I spent a good month in Fort Collins, Colorado (CSU) taking more seminary classes (Apologetics and Christ/Humanity/Salvation) as
